

2020 New Mexico Humanitarian Awards



The New Mexico Humanitarian Awards (NMHA) were created in 2007 to honor New Mexicans who have demonstrated an exemplary spirit of humanity in a local, national or international capacity. Organized and sponsored by the JCC in conjunction with outstanding local community partners, the Humanitarian Awards celebrate those who have selflessly devoted themselves to help others. Each award recognizes the pursuit of humanitarian goals, such as the promotion of human welfare, care and compassion, social reform, philanthropy, and values-based investing. Criteria for each award is reflected in the descriptions below and nominees are reviewed by the NMHA committee. Deadline for all nominations to be received is **Wednesday, April 1**.

Human Welfare/Care and Compassion

Recognizes an individual or organization that demonstrates a passion for human welfare through meaningful actions that impact the lives of under-served populations or provides services to those in challenging situations.

Social Reform

Recognizes those that exemplify a commitment to social change through actions that focus on the disadvantaged, the environment, health and social issues, or other community concerns.

Philanthropy

Recognizes an exceptional individual or family (foundations included) that has a history of financial support and volunteerism that supports local non-profits. They should also demonstrates a commitment to further promoting philanthropy within the community and/or state.

Values-based Investing

Recognizes exemplary leadership through financial and/or employee volunteer support in socially responsible investing that supports humanitarian purposes.

Harold B. Albert Jewish Community Service Award

Recognizes those whose service to the Jewish community reflects the highest integrity, love for others and commitment to the ideals of Jewish life
