
### **2025 Session Dates**

Camp Chai day campers participate in a variety of daily activities, including structured and elective time periods taught by specialists in their areas of expertise, to create their own unique summer experience. During each two-week session, campers enjoy a variety of classes and activities as part of their structured periods including: daily swim lessons and recreational swim time, art, dance, martial arts, social studies, outdoor education, science, Israeli culture, creative writing, movie making, gymnastics (K-2), digital media, performing arts, sports, and more. Themed weeks, special events, field and camp spirit days, and field trips are incorporated into each session. Before and after care services are available from 7-9AM and 4-6PM.

### Monday-Friday, July 28 - Aug. 1, 2025 \$325 member / \$425 non-member

Campers will investigate the fundamentals of designing, constructing, and bringing their own robots to life with LEGO® bricks, motors, gears, and many other electronic devices, in addition to learning how to maintain, fly, and understand the science behind flying drones, all while developing problem solving skills in both individual and small group activities. All materials are provided; bring your creativity and an open mind to join in the fun! In addition to the robotics and drone fun, campers will have the opportunity to enjoy the amenities of the JCC with daily swimming throughout this 5-day camp. Campers must bring athletic shoes, a bathing suit, a towel, and lunch, daily.

Cancellations can be made up to 2 weeks before the session begins. There is a \$75 non-refundable deposit per camper.

Art camp is a great opportunity for young artists to spend an entire, fun-packed week immersed in art making! Fun, creative themes will be woven into a full day of clay, two days of 2-D multi-media projects (drawing, painting, collage), and a day of 3-D recycled art.

Campers will learn the fundamentals of horseback riding, experience hands-on grooming, leading and basic care for horses. Each morning campers will ride for approximately 1.5-2 hours. Professional staff provide individual and group instruction. Campers must wear shoes with a heel for safety reasons, no tennis shoes. Finish the day with a refreshing splash in the beautiful JCC pool. Parents will drop off and pick up children at the JCC campus. Shlichim possess leadership, as well as other skills and talents that make them highly

motivated and dynamic role models to be working with our campers and staff.

The JCC needs families to host our two Israeli Schlichim camp counselors during the summer. This is a great way to bring an incredible cultural experience into you home for your campers and family! Host families will be asked to host for a minimum of two weeks, and during that time will be expected to provide: all meals; a comfortable, private bedroom space; and daily transportation to and from camp.
